- **Victims of crime** (including domestic violence)



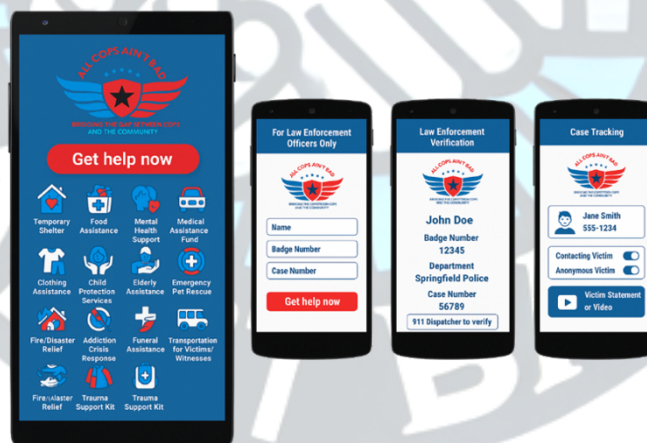

The program is supported through a mix of public and private streams:

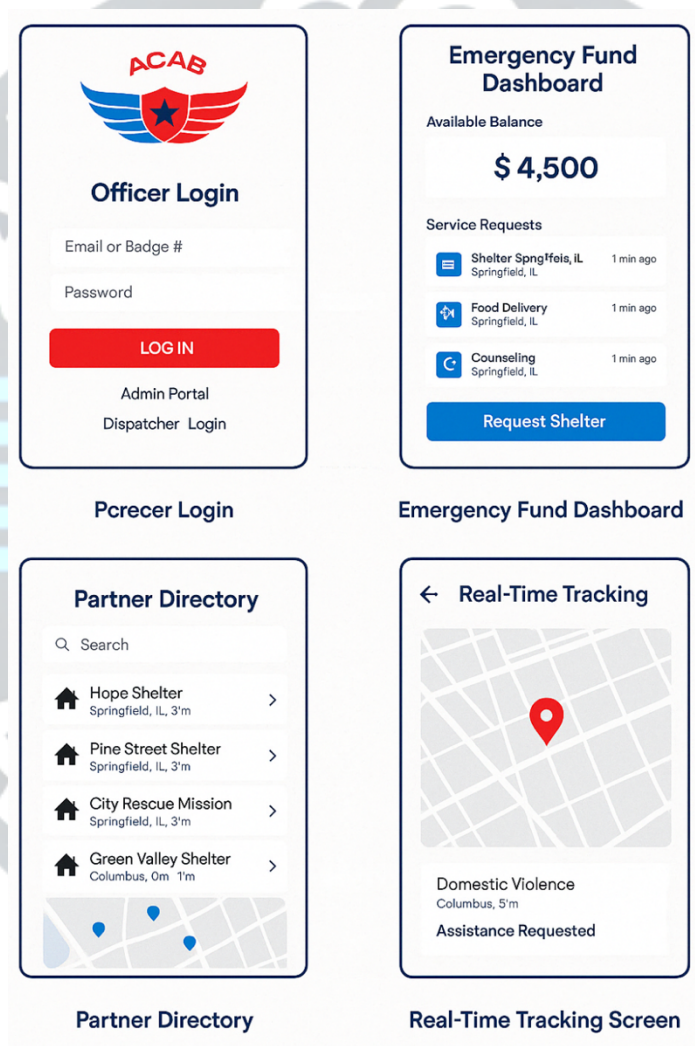

7. Financial Sustainability

Each U.S. state will receive **\$1 million annually**, distributed as follows:

- **\$600,000** for direct assistance
- **\$400,000** for program administration

Total U.S. Budget:

- **\$50 million/year** across all 50 states
 - \$30M for emergency assistance
 - \$20M for staffing, tech, and operations

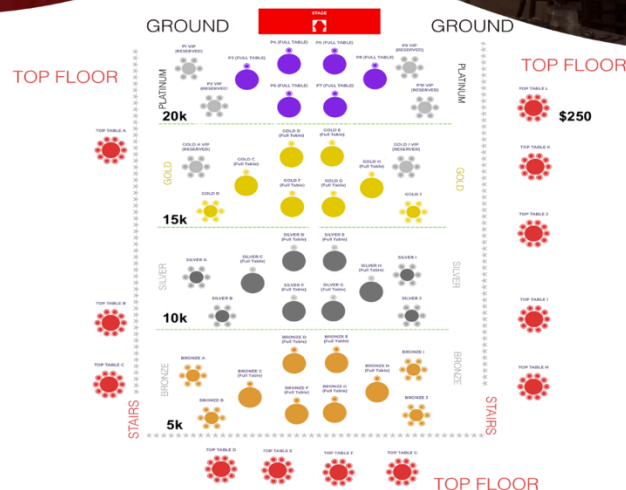
